Background

Nivethan is a not for profit organisation formed legally as a Trust. Nivethan was formed on March 13, 2006 by the people with expertise in different functionalities, a business person, an industrialist and a medical practitioner. Nivethan is very well supported by professionals in the areas of business, industry, technology, medical and engineering. Nivethan presently operates from Madurai.

Nivethan was found to benefit generally the suffering humanity without distinction of caste, creed or religion. Nivethan engages in activities of enhancing the lives of poor and vulnerable especially women, children and the old aged. Nivethan tries to ensure basic rights and sustainable development to the target population. Nivethan is presently engaged in activities related to food, healthcare and education.

Activities

Nivethan has formally started only after 3 years of engaging in variety of activities since 2003.

- a. Free siddha medical camps conducted with medicine on a weekly basis
- b. Free food provided on full moon days for more than three years
- c. Organizing water booths and free food packets on festive times
- d. Providing clothing to children belonging to various social organisations
- e. Supporting students of needy and qualified by payment of fees, amenities and counseling
- f. Free food supply to an entire village on all the new moon days for the last three years
- g. Consulting to enhance the activities to other associate NGOs in the region
- h. Has associated with MITRA in organizing blood donation camp for more than five years

Nivethan in 2008-2009 and the future

Nivethan as to the objectives of the people behind was focusing on women, children and the aged people; the two stages and the women were cared less by the younger generation of this period due to various reasons. Priority of youngsters of the country has transformed to meet the modern challenges of the fast and insecured positions sustaining the care taking in the past towards child, women and the aged. The focuses in this year, in this line, are Mission Thalassemia: Child Care Project and Chavadi: Caring Elders.

Mission Thalassemia

Nivethan in the natural process lead into support of children of this region affected by chronic and life time disease named Thalassemia. The children followed up in the Government Hospital, Madurai are focused and Nivethan extends support by way of

- a. Arranging donors for regular blood transmission to these patients
- b. Arranged a guidance meeting to the patient and their family with the support of medical experts
- c. Promoting awareness to public in general of the disease widely.

The possible treatment methods and funding proposals are in the process to meet the needs of the patient.

Caring elders

Chavadi, the inherent part of Nivethan, started to care the elders and their needs. A periodical discussion with expert people in arts, literature and religion was held and Chavadi has a plan to continue with more avenues to keep the time of aged people engaged to relax and rest.

CHAVADI has started a unique food for the aged program, one time meal for the destitute, deprived and distressed. The project has sparked strong reception from all the quarters and started on January 14, 2010 with a minimum strength. The inbuilt system has capacity to meet up to 25 persons in the scheme. The plan has potential for growth and expansion. The budget is totally funded by friends and relatives to start with the minimum level.

Plans for future

- Nivethan has a desire to have a comprehensive set up to care the ailing children of Thalassemia with utmost modern facilities. The recovery and restoration of a normal life to these children are the primary tasks and ambition of Nivethan.
- A complete relaxation center for the aged people comprising food, healthcare and recreation
- A modern academic environment to the children with all amenities to run is a serious consideration in the long run
